Rhine River Castles

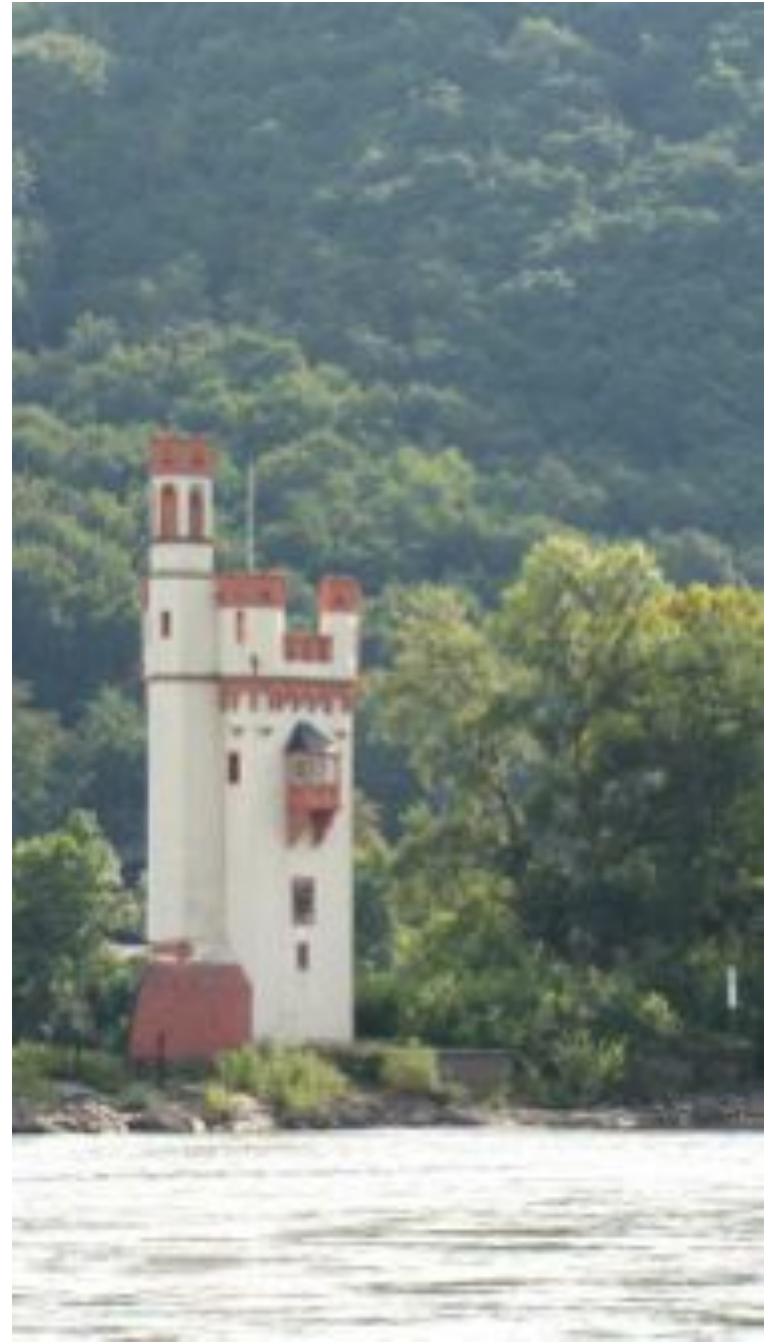
- There is a special stretch of the Rhine River that features the old castles that used to dominate this area in years past.

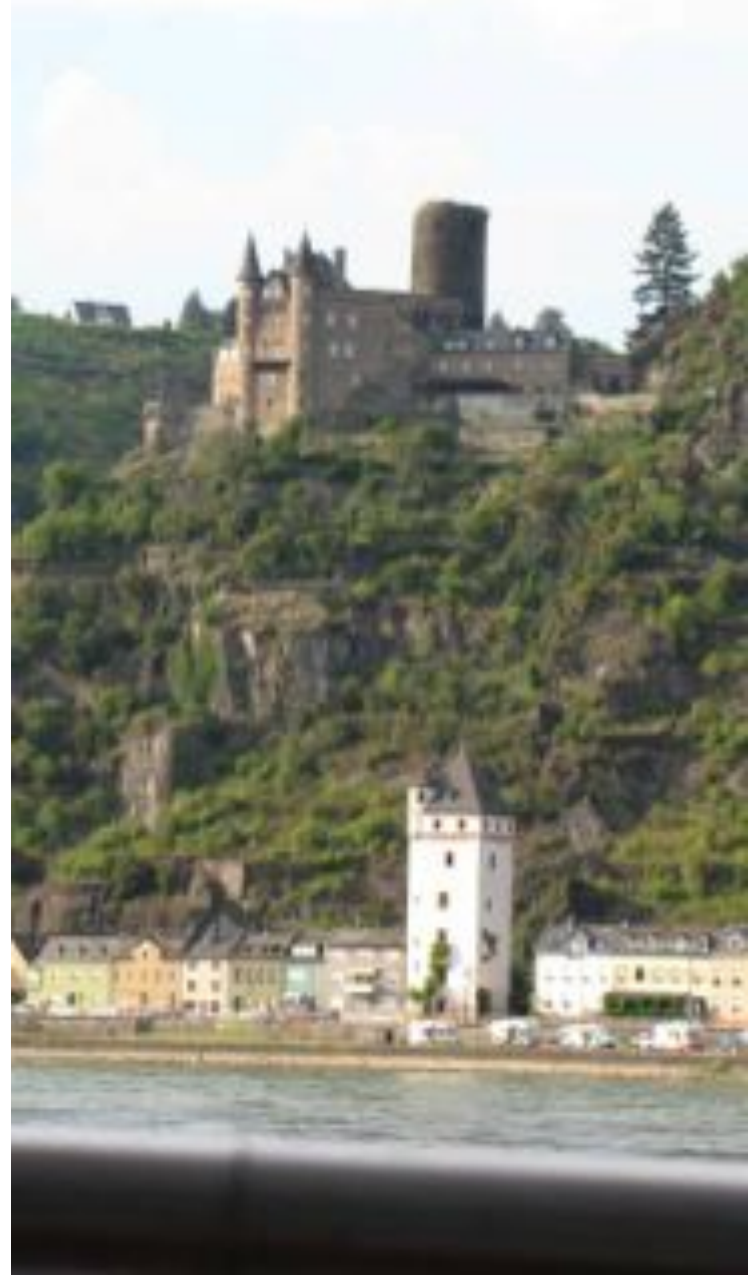
